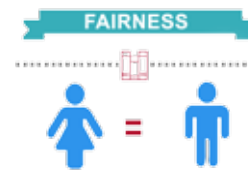
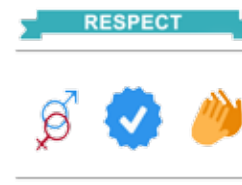

Academic excellence is a passion for us but so too is the overall well-being of all of our students, which is why pastoral care is at the heart of everything we do.

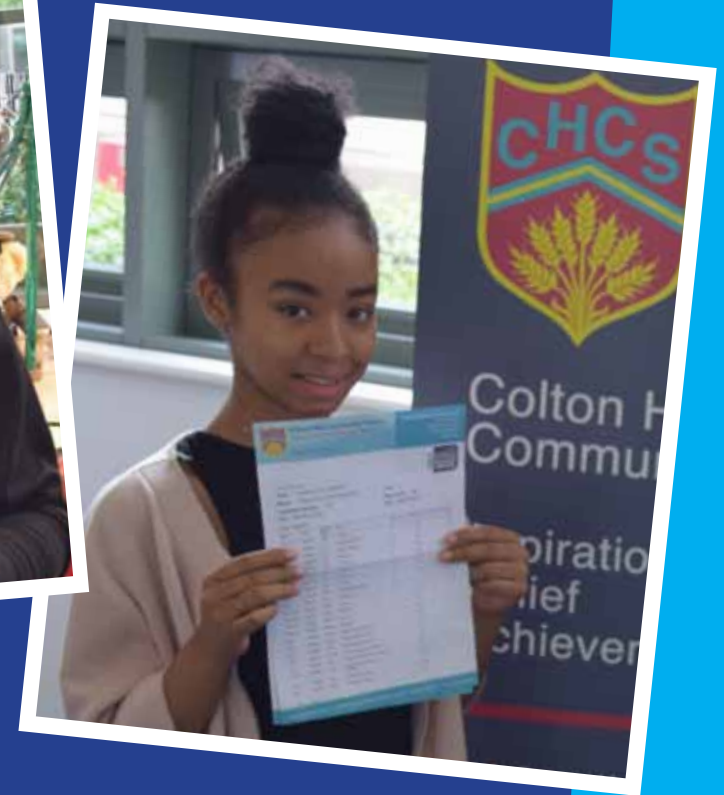
Students work collaboratively with teachers to set their own measurable targets to ensure they know exactly what to do to improve their work and achieve their full potential.
